PREFACE

A few words about the research are needed.

Frist, it is important that I try to support the data with documents or media that support the data of each individual. This helps to validate and provide confirmation of the genealogy history recorded about a person and their families. In some cases I have seen many forms of data, but I only attached those that provide proof to help support my recordings. If I attached all I could find would provide too much for my computer files and overload the presentation.

In United States history are numerous varieties of record types that have been preserved. Each of these records provide the trail of the people and their documented history. There are many sources that provide information of this documented history. In this book are footnotes of the source documents or places this research has been recorded. There are so many types of sources to mention here, but this book provides some of that information as recorded in my Family Tree Maker (FTM) file.

Some of the data has been found or learned but have no supporting documentation. Why? Because to maintain limited electronic files; and that some of the information has been discovered on many sources. In some cases, it is real information known by people of these families.

Ireland is divided by two territories. Northern Ireland, and The Republic of Ireland (the Irish Free State). Northern Ireland is under the control of British rule. The Republic of Ireland is its own sovereignty nation. The name "Éire" is the nickname or name used for Ireland.

First, one has to understand the land divisions of countries. This helps understanding to find people and where they lived.

One important note about individual and family names. Each surname coupled with given names you will find many of the same name or combination of names. Therefore, other items such as parents, birth, death, marriage, territory, and possible other items are required to ensure one has identified the current person and family.

Enjoy reading, but there is so much to learn. This document will provide a base for anyone wishing to do genealogy research or just adding to this family information.

RESEARCH NOTES

Doing genealogy research is a long term and time-consuming task. If one is doing it for real, they will collect a great amount of data about life of people, the territory they lived, and learn about the uniting of families. For this researcher, there is much learned that is way above what is taught about history in school classes. Research can include working with on-line resources in today's Internet and can include travel to obtain information and documentation from Federal, State, County, City, or towns from records they kept. Cemetery records are a great source found on-line via the Internet.

There are many avenues why folks do genealogy research. For this researcher, I am not writing a book, I am trying to learn of past family and a small bit about them. I am not recording every detail that is possible. If I did, I would not be able to share what I have discovered in this book and I would still be on the road to discovery.

What is in this book is free to all to read, print, or share as they desire. This information is public and can be found by others; therefore, I am not doing this for any monies or profit, just for the pleasure of doing this research and a great retirement hobby for me.

This research has been ongoing between 2000 to 2021 to compile and record in this book. There are many resources, these are just some of them.

The following is a sampling about what I used to do research.

- 3. Using an Internet browser to search by varies names or phrases does help locate some information.
- 4. Primary source documents such as: US Census, Birth, Death certificates, cemetery records, civil documents, and immigration records or other documents that support the validation of family names and their link to relatives.
- 5. Find-a-Grave: [https://www.findagrave.com/]. In the attached files you may see the term "Memorial ID" with a number sequence. By going to the Find a Grave web site and entering this Memorial ID, that will take you to the grave information that has been recorded by folks who go to cemeteries and document the graves. In some cases, you will see the grave maker and other information folks have recorded for that person. In some cases, there are links to parents, siblings, and children along with spouses that all have a Memorial ID recorded.
- 6. Historical Societies and Internet Genealogy resources

NOTES:

- 1) ANCESTOR: Also known as a forefather, fore-elder or a forebear.
- 2) DESCENDANT: Are descending after a forefather, fore-elder or a forebear.
 - Meaning of "direct descendant" as opposed to "indirect descendant"
 - 1. A direct descendant is someone who can trace their lineage by "child" relationships all the way back to the desired ancestor.

2. A non-direct descendant has to go through a "cousin" or "by marriage" or some other non-child relationship in order to find the desired ancestor.

Definition of genealogy.

- 1. An account of the descent of a person, family, or group from an ancestor or from older forms.
- 2. Regular descent of a person, family, or group of organisms from a progenitor or older form: pedigree. The study of family ancestral lines.

Another fact, naming of children was set forth by family protocol in family history. Therefore, caution is required as one will see the same names in many families resulting with the same names used very often and can only be identified by parents, birth, death dates and/or other factors.

It is amazing how often there is a close resemblance for relatives separated by generations.

There are many paper trails of recorded facts and information. The discovery of those paper trails helps find the information about families that provide the ancestral connections to people. This book is about those finding but begins with a known person and provides their descendants or ancestors and all related folks that have been recorded in my files.

The program creating this book is a great tool. It uses data from the Family Tree Maker (FTM) data base; However, the words or sentences that this program provides can, sometimes, or may not have the proper syntax of the English language. Introduction

The following pages list data for all known family members as of June 02, 2022.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children.

Any files/Media collected is attached to a person or family is pictured with each family.

The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. Each spouse and their children is a "Nuclear Family".

For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family.

Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Family of the Starting Person" the ancestors of Anna Cahill are presented in a form of an enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose ancestors are listed in the later chapters.

The chapter titled "<HeadlineFamilies>" provides details (as known as of this publication date) for the ancestors of Anna Cahill.

There is a chapter for each generation.


Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

Sources for the information provided are given in the footnotes.

This document reports the details of 59 individuals, of whom 26 are male and 33 are female. Of the 51 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 67.3 years. Of these, 23 males averaged 70.4 years, and 28 females averaged 64.7 years. The longest living male was Winfield S. Harper (1903–1994), who died aged 91. The longest living female was Mary Frances Clement (1898–1996), who died aged 98.

1.0-3 Anna Maria Cahill was born on Tuesday, December 12, 1865, in Villanova, Clinton, Iowa, US.^[1-3] She was the daughter of Patrick J. Cahill Sr. (1.1-1) and Hannah Quigley (2.1-1).

Her religious affiliation was Catholic. She died in DeWitt, Clinton, Ia, on July 07, 1943, at the age of 77.

Her cause of death was Acute Myocarditis -- Arteriosclerosis. She was buried in DeWitt, Clinton, Ia., US (St. Josephs Cemetery).

Person Notes: According to a 1880 & 1900 census report the name of Maria is listed as Thomas' wife. Other reports received had the name as Mariah. Grandchildren of William F. Hanrahan (Maria's son) had known her name to be Mariah

Possible the name may be Maria Ann. It is believed her name is Maria but she used the name Mariah. However, in census as a child, she is listed a Maria. In newspaper abstracts found on the Internet for her marriage, she is listed as Anna Maria; thus the reason for the listing in this record.

Also on that 1900 census report, she had 4 children but only 3 were living at the time of the census. This indicates a child born and had died. Census reports they were married for 9 years indicating the oldest child died as an infant.

Obituary notice listed mentioned all the children that included the name of the oldest child that died as an infant. She had 6 children, of which 2 died in their early youth.

She was a great cook always having some baking goods on hand. She told grandson William Hanrahan Jr. about providing food to the Indians in Nebraska. They would smell food and hang around the home but would leave as soon as she gave them some food. Mainly the bread

At the age of 25, Anna Maria married **Thomas John Hanrahan Sr** on Wednesday, January 28, 1891, in Villanova, Clinton, Iowa, US, when he was 26 years old. They had six children: Patrick, Theresa, Thomas, Agnes, William and Daisy.

His religious affiliation was Catholic. Thomas John was employed in 1900 in Reports as a Farmer. He was employed in 1910 in Reports as a Cement laborer. Thomas John was employed in 1930 in Odd Jobs, Laborer.

Thomas John reached 68 years of age and died at Cancer of the Stomach in DeWitt, Clinton, Iowa, USA, on April 19, 1933.^[4, 5] His cause of death was Carcinoma of Stomach / M. Scanlan, M.D. Thomas John was buried in DeWitt, Clinton, Ia., US (St. Josephs Cemetery), on April 22, 1933.^[4]

Person NotesA 1900 census report has the family listed living in Wisner, Nebraska. Thomas is listed as a Farmer renting his home. This census report confirms information listed on the family group sheet for children and birth dates of month and year along with birth locations by State of Country.

Obituary of Son Thomas states they moved to Iowa locating on a farm near Villa Nova, Clinton, Ia. And family is found in 1880 census in this location. In 1885 Iowa state census, the family is found living in Westside, Crawford, Iowa. Crawford County, Iowa is located north west of Des Moines about 35 miles east of the Nebraska boarder. Monona County is between Crawford and the Nebraska boarder. Westside is a small town located on the eastern edge of Crawford County.

1900 Census living Wisner township, Cumings, Nebraska, USA. Line 57, page 3 working as a farmer.

Also found on the 1900 census report is a Thomas Hanrahan of Stuart, Holt county, Ne. He was living alone. Not known if any relation but census report shows place of birth to be different than any Hanrahan's of this parentage. He was considerably older than Thomas.

An obituary states Thomas lived in DeWitt for 32 years, he died in 1933, this means they moved back to DeWitt about 1901 but a 1910 census reports daughter Margaret was born in Nebraska in 11/1904. May be possible he returned to DeWitt first to establish a home and returned to Nebraska to bring his family back to DeWitt, or the birth location noted in reports of daugter Margaret is not correct.

Death Certificate states he was 68 years, 9 months, 15 days of age at time of death.

He died in DeWitt, Clinton, Ia., US, on January 05, 1962, at the age of 65.[11, 13] Thomas John was buried in DeWitt, Clinton, Ia., US (Elmwood Cemetery).[11, 13]

She retired in 1986. Walker Department Store, Dewitt, Iowa. Mary Frances reached 98 years of age and died in DeWitt, Clinton, Ia., US, on October 28, 1996. She was buried in DeWitt, Clinton, Ia., US (Elmwood Cemetery), on October 31, 1996.

Mary attended Malone Country School, graduated from DeWitt Public School in 1917 and then went one year to Cedar Falls.

He trained the dogs and also took some of the dogs to many dog shows were he showed them to judges and would win sometimes.

After moving to California was the only time he didn't do the job of painting and decorating. They owned a small grocery store and he was the butcher in the store. The store was located at 12370 So Highway 9 (road is now known as Saratoga Sunnyvale Road) in Cupertino but boundries later changes and it became Saratoga, California. It was located, then, in the middle of the orchard country. After they sold the store, He worked as a painter most of the time, but on occassion hung wall paper for clients.

William's dad was a drayage worker (heavy wagon and horse. He helped his dad build a barn to house the wagon and horse. He also, told me of working with the town Doctor. They would ride in the doctors buggy with a horse attached. If the doctor needed something from town, my Dad would ride the horse back to town to retireve the doctors items and meet him at the next stop.

His painting crew painted the catholic church steeple. A very large land mark in DeWitt.




Figure 4: Hanrahan Maria 1940 Census (8/5/2020 3:13:36 PM)




Figure 13: Hanrahan Maria 1940 (8/4/2020 3:38:44 PM)




Figure 15: 1870 United States Federal Census (1870)




Figure 17: Iowa, State Census Collection, 1836-1925




Figure 16: Iowa, Death Records, 1920-1940 State Historical Society of Iowa; Des Moines, Iowa; Iowa Death Records; Reference Number: 101797054





Figure 18: Thomas Hanrahan 1920 United States Federal Census (1920)

They first lived in Pennsylvania where he married his wife, Hannah Quigley. they moved to Iowa and in 1868 purchased 40 acres of land in 'Eden Township. He has added to his holdings 120 acres of well improved, choice land. His father and wife are buried at St. Marv's Cemetery.

Patrick has always followed farming and has been very successful and has valuable land and a good comfortable home as well as necessary out-buildings for farming and his stock.

Patrick is a Democrat and a faithful member of the Catholic Church. Six children were born to Patrick and his wife Hannah. Sarah, Mary, Mariah, Thomas, Patrick Jr., and Elizabeth. Patrick and Elizabeth are on the farm with their father.

Six children were born to them, all of whom are living, namely: Sarah, born February 24, 1860, is the wife of Henry Laentjes, of Clinton county; Mary, born August 25, 1863, is the wife of M. Generic History of our Name The Cahill name is one of the oldest in Europe. The Irish had surnames very early, and O'Cahill was one of the first. The earliest recorded person of our name was a monk, Flan O'Cahill, who died in 938 A.D. It is extremely unlikely that anyone can trace a member of his or her family back to Flan's family. The O'Cahills have links back to Irish pagan leaders in the 200s and 400s A.D. By 1000 A.D. the O'Cahills controlled much of south Galway, east Clare, and western and northern Tipperary. This predominance was ended in the 1200s by the O'Shaugnessys and the O'Donoghues, perhaps both in alliance with the Norman-English who had recently arrived in Ireland. Those 13th century defeats may have led to the loss in most lines of their "O," which indicates both descent and predominance. However it happened, by 1659 the name "O'Cahill" had been almost entirely replaced by "Cahill" as a common surname in a listing of workers on the large farms following the English Cromwellian land confiscations. Today Cahill is the most common surname in Munster, the old southwestern province, which includes the counties of Clare, Limerick, Kerry, Cork, Waterford, and Tipperary. The Irish there pronounce it with the accent on the first syllable with a short "a" and in the last

syllable an almost-swallowed "h". This can be described as pronounced "CA" (accented) as in cattle, and "hill" as hull

Thomas and Elizabeth farmed in Orange Township, Clinton County and later owned and operated a butcher shop in Grand Mound, Iowa. In 1905 the family consisting of Thomas, Elizabeth and children Mary, Theresa, Ellen Rosalie, William Francis and Thomas Aloysius moved to South Dakota. They purchased a farm and after two years sold it to other settelers from Iowa and bought a farm in Wilbur Township, known a the Cahill farm, and there raised their family.

When Thomas purchased the farm it had on-half section or 320 ares of land. Eventually he bought anther half-section, then a quarter section and later added another half section for a total 1120 acres. They built a fine home on their farm which is standing vacant and in disrepair in 1997.

The move to South Dakota was prompted by our pioneer ancestors looking for land. All the Iowa land was taken -- no more home steading so they continue the westward movement.

Thomas would speak to his sons of how important it was to own land. He grew to love the South Dakota prairie lands but Elizbeth never convinced herself there was anything in South Dakota that equaled the green of eastern Iowa. Much of the farm was in grass as there was hogs, cattle and horses on the Cahill farm. Good horses were a must on the Cahill farm and they had many horses. Thomas had four boys and most of the time a hired man to help with

the unending work. His theory was to break the sod and plant wheat and corn. At the time it worked very well. The framing was done with 3 or 4 horse team.

The lived on their farm until 1924 when they moved to Kimball and their sons, T.A., Bill, And Dode continued to live on the farm. The farm was foreclosed upon in 1934 during the Depression.

"John Quigley, was born in county Tipperary, Ireland, in 1802 where he married Bridget Riordan, About 1832, he left Ireland with his wife and four children and came to America, locating in New York City, where he was employed in the grocery trade for a few years. He then removed to Buffalo, N.Y., thence to Ottawa, where he engaged in the grocery trade and also conducted a hotel till fall. In 1849 he went to Cattaraugus County, N. Y. The New York & Erie Railroad was in process of construction at the time and he undertook contracts to build various portions of the same.

He completed his labors in New York in the fall of 1853, and in December started West. coming as far as Chicago, where he left his family until he could secure a location. Coming to Clinton County he selected a claim and took up land which now lies in Washington Township. He then walked to lowa City and entered the land, 240 acres, at the Govern-Township. 


Figure 26: 1880 United States Federal Census Year: 1880; Census Place: Lyons, Clinton, Iowa; Roll: 334; Page: 104A; Enumeration District: 287





Figure 27: 1910 United States Federal Census Year: 1910; Census Place: Eden, Clinton, Iowa; Roll: T624_398; Page: 6A; Enumeration District: 0023; FHL microfilm: 1374411

Generic History of our Name The Cahill name is one of the oldest in Europe. The Irish had surnames very early, and O'Cahill was one of the first. The earliest recorded person of our name was a monk, Flan O'Cahill, who died in 938 A.D. It is extremely unlikely that anyone can trace a member of his or her family back to Flan's family. The O'Cahills have links back to Irish pagan leaders in the 200s and 400s A.D. By 1000 A.D. the O'Cahills controlled much of south Galway, east Clare, and western and northern Tipperary. This predominance was ended in the 1200s by the O'Shaugnessys and the O'Donoghues, perhaps both in alliance with the Norman-English who had recently arrived in Ireland. Those 13th century defeats may have led to the loss in most lines of their "O," which indicates both descent and predominance. However it happened, by 1659 the name "O'Cahill" had been almost entirely replaced by "Cahill" as a common surname in a listing of workers on the large farms following the English Cromwellian land confiscations. Today Cahill is the most common surname in Munster, the old southwestern province,

The Irish there pronounce it with the accent on the first syllable with a short "a" and in the last syllable an almost-swallowed "h". 


Figure 30: 1870 United States Federal Census Year: 1870; Census Place: Washington, Clinton, Iowa; Roll: M593_385; Page: 418B; Family History Library Film: 545884




Figure 31: 1880 United States Federal Census Year: 1880; Census Place: Washington, Clinton, Iowa; Roll: 334; Page: 261C; Enumeration District: 293


Figure 33: U.S., Selected Federal Census Non-Population Schedules, 1850-1880 Census Year: 1880; Census Place: Washington, Clinton, Iowa; Archive Collection Number: T1156; Roll: 20; Page: 6; Line: 1; Schedule Type: Agriculture



"John Quigley, was born in county Tipperary, Ireland, in 1802 where he married Bridget Riordan. About 1832, he left Ireland with his wife and four children and came to America, locating in New York City, where he was employed in the grocery trade for a few years. He then removed to Buffalo, N.Y., thence to Ottawa, where he engaged in the grocery trade and also conducted a hotel till fall. In 1849 he went to Cattaraugus County, N. Y. The New York & Fire Railroad was in process of construction at the time and he undertook contracts to build various portions of the same.

He completed his labors in New York in the fall of 1853, and in December started West, coming as far as Chicago, where he left his family until he could secure a location. Coming to Clinton County he selected a claim and took up land which now lies in Washington ing to Clinton County he selected a claim and took up land which now lies in Washington Township.
