PREFACE

A few words about the research are needed.

Frist, it is important that I try to support the data with documents or media that support the data of each individual. This helps to validate and provide confirmation of the genealogy history recorded about a person and their families.

In United States history are numerous varieties of record types that have been preserved. Each of these records provide the trail of the people and their documented history. There are many sources that provide information of this documented history. In this book are footnotes of the source documents or places this research has been recorded. There are so many types of sources to mention here, but this book provides some of that information as recorded in my Family Tree Maker (FTM) file.

Some of the data has been found or learned but have no supporting documentation. Why? Because to maintain limited electronic files; and that some of the information has been discovered on many sources. In some cases, it is real information known by people of these families.

Countries may have been divided by different areas. It may be neccesary to learn about a countries administrative divisions.

One other note about individual and family names. Each surname coupled with given names, there are many of the same name or combination of names. Therefore, other items such as birth, death, marriage, territory, and possible other items are required to ensure one has identified the current person or family.

It's important that you ensure that you valid a finding. Just because a name make look correct, it takes documented validation of at least 3 or more documents to prove that you found the correct individual or family.

Enjoy reading, but there is so much to learn. This document will provide a base for anyone wishing to do genealogy research or just adding to this family information.

RESEARCH NOTES

Doing genealogy research is a long term and time-consuming task. If one is doing it for real, they will collect a great amount of data about their lives, about the territory they lived, and learn about the integration of families. For this researcher, there is much learned that is way above what is taught about history in school classes. Research can include working with on-line resources and can include travel to obtain information and documentation from Federal, State, County, City, or towns from records they keep. Cemetery records are a great source found on-line via the Internet.

There are many avenues why folks do genealogy research. For this researcher, I am not writing a book, I am trying to learn of past family and a small bit about them. I am not recording every detail that is possible. If I did, I would not be able to share what I have discovered in this book and I would still be on the road to discovery.

What is in this book is free to all to read, print, or share as they desire. This information is public and can be found by others; therefore, I am not doing this for any monies or profit, just for the pleasure of doing this research and a great retirement hobby for me.

This research has been ongoing since 2000 to compile and record in the attached book. There are many resources, these are just some of them.

The following is a sampling about what I used to do research.

- 1. Ancestry.com [https://www.ancestry.com/] web site. (Pay to use)
- 2. "Family Search" [https://wwwfamilysearchh.org/en/] (Free to the public] web site that is open to anyone. This site is created and supported by The Latter-Day Saints in Salt Lake City, Utah (aka Mormon Church or LDS).
- 3. Internet browser to search by varies names or phrases does help locate some information.
- 4. Primary source documents such as: US Census, Birth, Death certificates, cemetery records, civil documents, and immigration records or other documents that support the validation of family names and their link to relatives.
- 5. Find-a-Grave: [https://www.findagrave.com/]. In the attached files you may see the term "*Memorial ID*" with a number sequence. By going to the Find a Grave web site and entering this Memorial ID, that will take you to the grave information that has been recorded by folks who go to cemeteries and document the graves. In some cases, you will see the grave maker and other information folks have recorded for that person. In some cases, there are links to parents, siblings, and children along with spouses that all a Memorial ID recorded.
- 6. Historical Societies and Internet Genealogy resources

NOTES:

1) ANCESTOR: Also known as a forefather, fore-elder or a forebear.

- 2) DESCENDANT: Are descending after a forefather, fore-elder or a forebear.
 - Meaning of "direct descendant" as opposed to "indirect descendant"
 - 1. A direct descendant is someone who can trace their lineage by "child" relationships all the way back to the desired ancestor.
 - 2. A non-direct descendant has to go through a "cousin" or "by marriage" or some other nonchild relationship in order to find the desired ancestor.

Definition of genealogy.

- 1. An account of the descent of a person, family, or group from an ancestor or from older forms.
- 2. Regular descent of a person, family, or group of organisms from a progenitor or older form: pedigree. The study of family ancestral lines.

This book contains the facts, who, where, when, but not the story of **A FAMILY**. But it is the story of **MANY FAMILIES** along with some information of basic facts and notes.

It is about the descendants or ancestors of the surnamed person related to all people listed in this book. Note: over time the surname may change as this was due to a language interpretation of the words from another language to English. In some cases, it is how a person hearing a name pronounced and thought what they heard and consequently spelled the name differently.

Another fact, naming of children was set forth by family protocol in family history. Therefore, caution is required as one will see the same names in many families resulting with the same names used very often and can only be identified by birth and death dates and/or other factors.

It is amazing how often there is a close resemblance for relatives separated by generations.

There are many paper trails of recorded facts and information. The discovery of those paper trails helps find the information about families that provide the ancestral connections to people. This book is about those finding but begins with a known person and provides their descendants or ancestors and all related folks that have been recorded in my files.

DISCLAIMER

The program creating this book is a great tool. It uses data from the Family Tree Maker (FTM) data base; However, the words or sentences that this program provides can, sometimes, or may not have the proper syntax of the English language. That is not an error, but it is a terrific programming task to make all the syntax blend with the data from FTM as best as possible. Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children.

The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number.

For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family.

Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Families of the Starting Person" the ancestors of Holly Jones are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose ancestors are listed in the later chapters.

The chapter titled "<HeadlineFamilies>" provides details (as known as of this publication date) for the ancestors of Holly Jones.

There is a chapter for each generation.

Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

Sources for the information provided are given in the footnotes.

This document reports the details of 125 individuals, of whom 61 are male and 64 are female. Of the 99 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 66.4 years. Of these, 52 males averaged 67.3 years, and 47 females averaged 65.4 years. The longest living male was Peter Dyer (1754–1848), who died aged 94. The longest living female was Ruth Wightman (1605–1717), who died aged 112.








Figure 2: Patterson Sr Mickie Lewis California, Marriage Index, 1960-1985(4)(1) (10/18/2018 4:42:43 PM)




Figure 4: Liddicoat Patterson California, Divorce Index, 1966-1984 (1978)




Figure 6: Patterson Mickie Lewis (5/13/2019 7:57:22 PM)





Levi served in the 71st Infantry, Company K, of the Illinois Volunteers from July to October 1862, during the Civil War. He was a life long resident of Franklin County, and a progressive farmer who built the first concrete silo in southern Illinois.

His maternal grandfather Bellamy was a man of high integrity and was widely known because of his activities as a member of the Order of Ancient Free and Accepted Masons.

Herschel "Casey" Jones met his future wife at the post office in Rend City, Illinois, where she was working. He and Gussie Ingram were married October 27, 1918, Edwards, Illinois. Seven children were born to them, four daughters and three sons.

Casey loved cars and made his living as a mechanic in Carlyle and Centralia, Illinois. He also enjoyed outdoor activities including hunting, fishing and gardening.

The family had a rustic cabin by the river when their children were young in the 1930's. The children fondly recall summers there working hard at their chores, gardening, fishing and picking berries to keep the family fed. But, they also remember the fun of making up their own entertainment, swimming in the river and playing with their siblings. Their mother was handy with a gun, if needed, to keep snakes and other critters away.

Their father treated them one summer to a special surprise for all their hard work at the cabin. He took them to a Cubs and Cardinals game in St. Louis one Sunday. So unexpected, it was a day they would never forget!

For many years Casey's official name was listed as Herschel "Byron" Jones. He explained that on his WW II Draft Card they had listed his middle name as Byron instead of Barron. He tried to get them to correct it, but it wasn't done. So, he gave up and signed it as Byron. Many years after he died his daughter found confirmation that Casey's true middle name "Baron" was actually spelled "Barron."

Gussie met her husband Casey Jones while working at the post office in Rend City, Illinois. They married October 27,1918 and had seven children, four daughters and three sons. They raised their family at Carlyle and Centralia, Illinois.

Gussie grew up loving music and could still play her organ in the later years of her life. Her son Tom's life long love of music most likely came from her.

When her children were teenagers, they were allowed to roll up the rugs, push back the furniture and invite friends over to enjoy music and dancing to records on the Victrola. Gussie would make huge bowls of popped corn and serve a popular fruit drink.

In the 1930's, Gussie was the parent in charge during summers at their rustic cabin by the river. 


Figure 8: Jones Census 1930 Bexar County, Texas, Precinct #6 Near San Antonio, Texas (6/23/2019 1:56:08 PM) Census, see marked




Figure 9: Jones 1940 Census Harris County, Texas Justice Precent near Houston (6/23/2019 2:37:48 PM) Census seen marker




Figure 14: Jones Levi 1880 Census (6/30/2019 12:17:59 AM) Levi Jones




Figure 17: Jones Levi 1910 census Illinois (6/30/2019 12:29:19 AM) Levi Jones 1910 census





Figure 19: Jones Levi Marriage Susanna Winn (6/30/2019 12:38:18 AM) Levi and Susanna Marriage Certificate

Her birthplace was near the site of Zeigler which then did not exist." Her twin brothers James K and William R, born December 23, 1810 were the first white twins born in the county.

founded July 11, 1829. Her name is on the cornerstone along with her parents. Her father was the church minister.



Black Hawk's band was weakened by hunger, death, and desertion and many native survivors retreated towards the Mississippi. On August 2, U.S. soldiers attacked the remnants of the British Band at the Battle of Bad Axe, killing many or capturing most who remained alive. Black Hawk and other leaders escaped, but later surrendered and

were imprisoned for a year.

The Black Hawk War gave the young captain Abraham Lincoln his brief military service, although he never participated in a battle.[4] Other participants who later became famous included Winfield Scott, Zachary Taylor, and Jefferson Davis. 


Figure 23: Caulfield Jesse 1917 Draft Registration (6/25/2019 8:45:15 PM) 1917 Draft Registration Card




Figure 26: Caulfield Jesse 1930 Census (6/30/2019 12:14:14 AM) Caulfield





Figure 27: Caulfield Jesse 1940 Census (6/30/2019 12:14:51 AM) Caulfield




Figure 28: Caulfield Issac Robert 1910 Census of Cooke Texas (6/25/2019 8:05:51 PM) Issac Robert Caulfield





Figure 29: Caulfield Issac Robert 1920 Census of Cooke Texas (6/25/2019 8:14:01 PM) Issac Robert Caulfield
